What are we learning?

2nd grade's theme is SYSTEMS. We are beginning our focus on Earth Systems!

Speaking of systems: Both Ms. Browning and Ms. Jackson use a money system in their classes. Students receive money (fake money that is) for staying on task, doing the right things, completing work and class jobs, and much more. Money can be spent to buy privileges and prizes. This system helps us to teach a 2nd grade standard Time and Money. Students learn the value of coins and counting money helps to practice math facts, and addition and subtraction.

Responsive Classroom:
