Thanks for coming to Open House last night! It was a great way for your student to show you what they learned, and teach you about it as well.

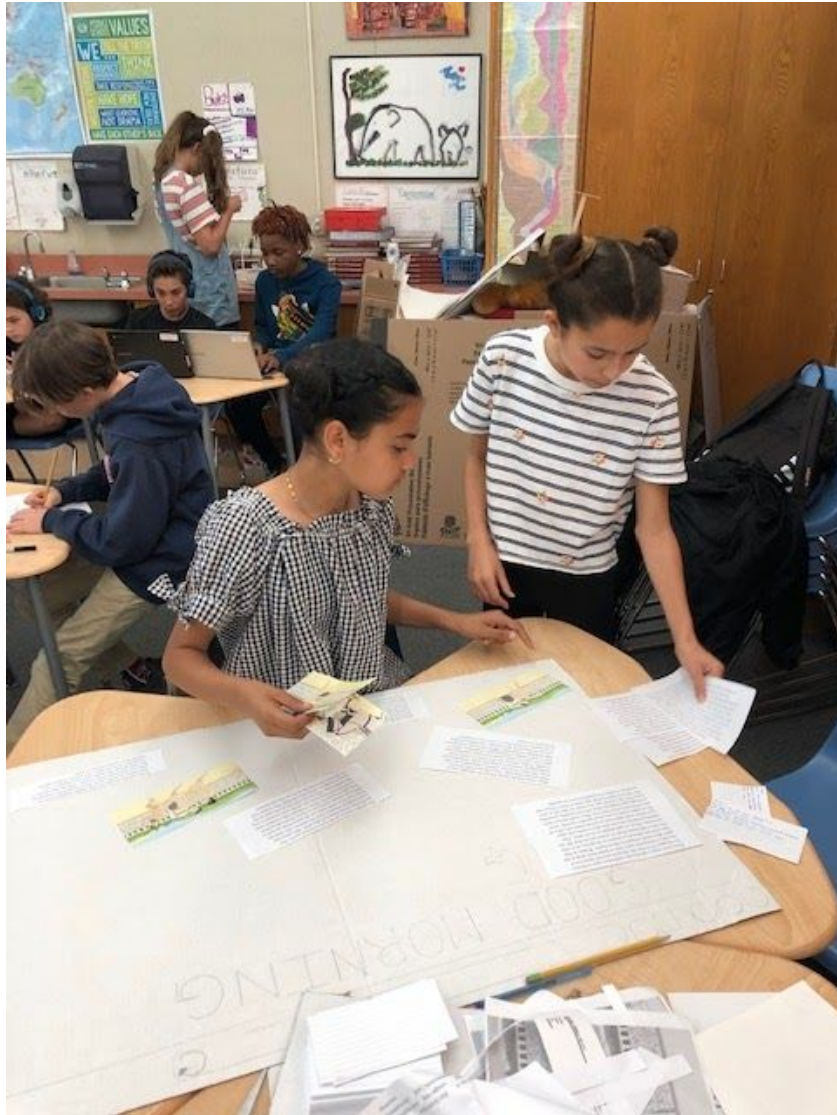

In science we've investigated random questions we've had throughout the year by answering them. We've learned about animal adaptations, and we've played some science trivia.

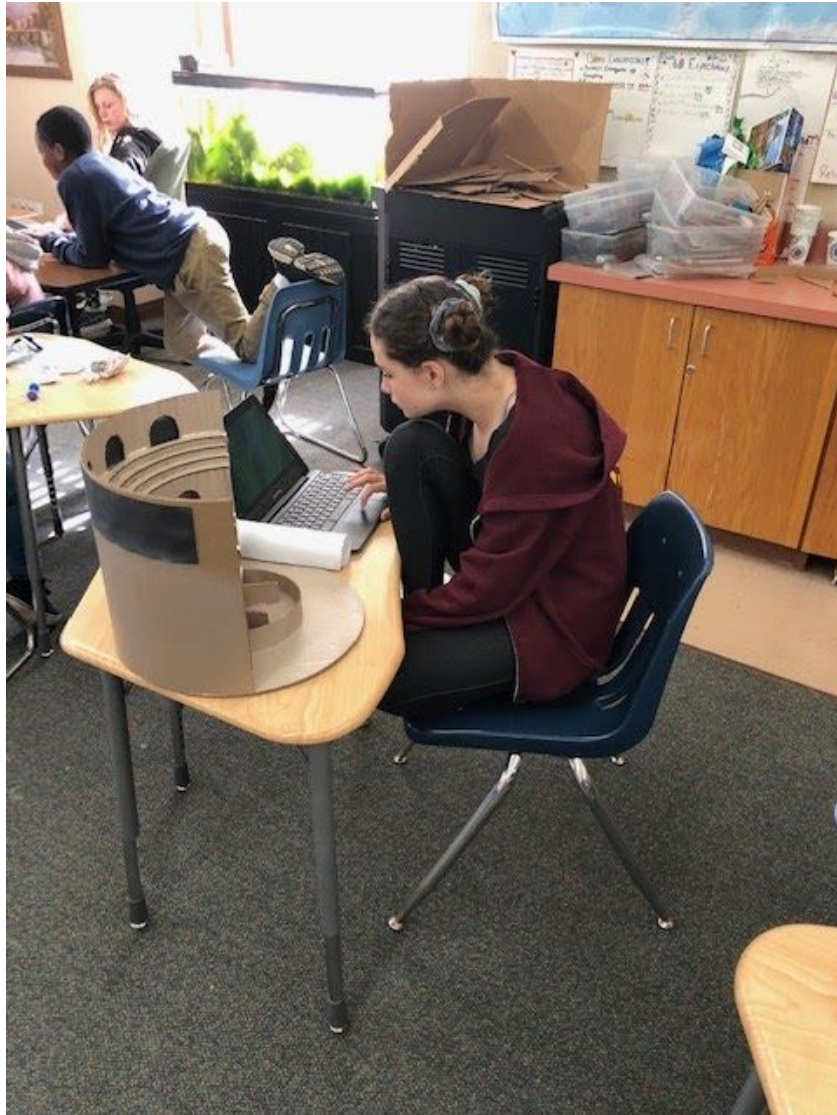

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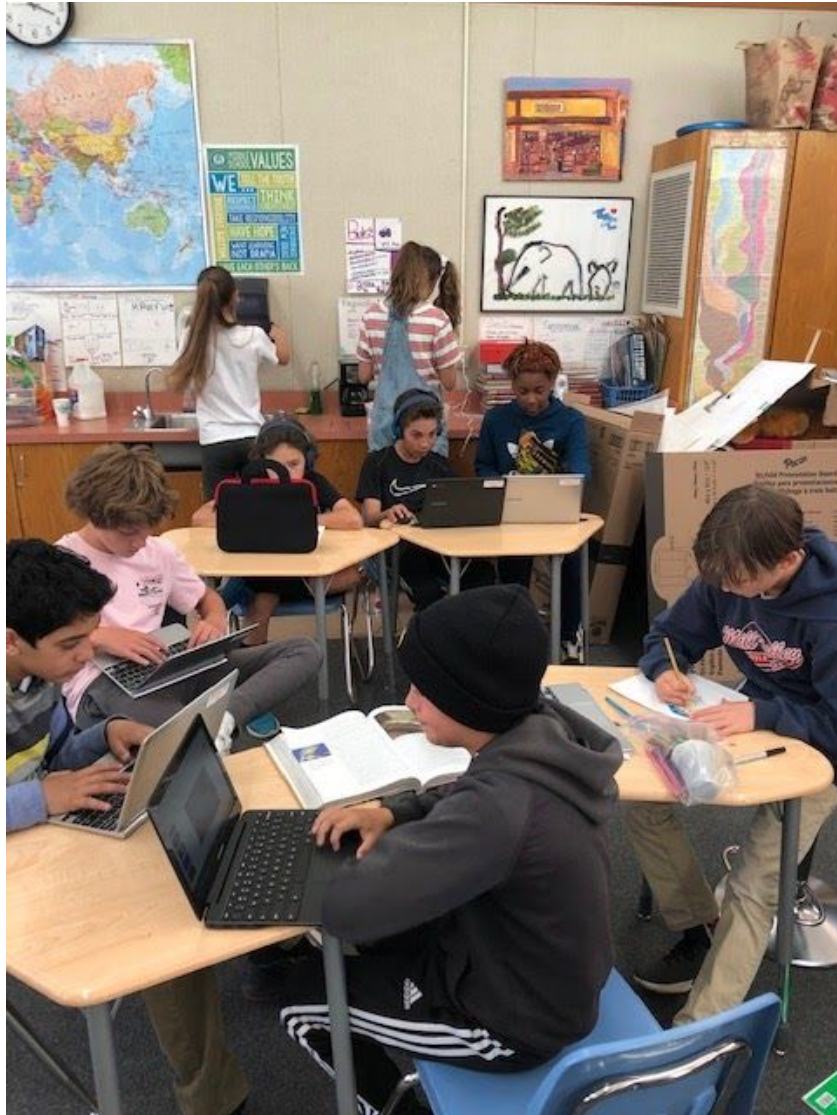


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
