In the fertile crescent people had a stable food supply which led to the development of art, technology, social structures, governments, religion and written language.</p> <p>We are reading a condensed version of the Epic of Gilgamesh considered to be the world's earliest surviving work of literature. The story is compiled from Sumerian poetry and myths in the Akkadian language.
