We had a great week and the kids really enjoyed writing/sharing about their spring breaks! We were so impressed with the details they used to capture their favorite memory from the break. We continued our weather unit by learning about the season of spring. We are using our five senses to describe spring in different ways. This week we also wrapped up our 3D geometry unit. We compared and made models of 3D shapes and matched the shapes of the faces on 3D figures. We also practiced using ten frames to track attendance.

We also read another CVC book that focused on the short vowel sound "o." This book was sent home and the CVC words on the last page of this book are a great way to practice reading words with the short o sound. We've also continued using our word wall to recognize snap words (sight words) that are tricky to sound out. In Writer's Workshop we completed our narrative unit.
