Highlights from Ms.Perez & Ms.Alison's Room

- ✚ In Language Arts we continued to eat the alphabet, tracking and practicing the beginning sounds of everything we ate. The kids really love this!
- ✚ We began talking about Fall and learning about pumpkins. We wrote down all of the things we know about pumpkins, and what we would like to learn, and we also painted our own pumpkins, big and small.
- ✚ In Math we continued using Dreambox. We also matched buttons based on their attributes, counted them out and wrote the numbers, and make pumpkin seed ten frame books.

Highlights from Ms. Hope & Ms. Mayes's Room

- ✚ We continued learning about Fall and created our first KWL chart (prior Knowledge, Wonders, and what we Learned)
