JOIN US FOR A FLASHLIGHT VIGIL TO

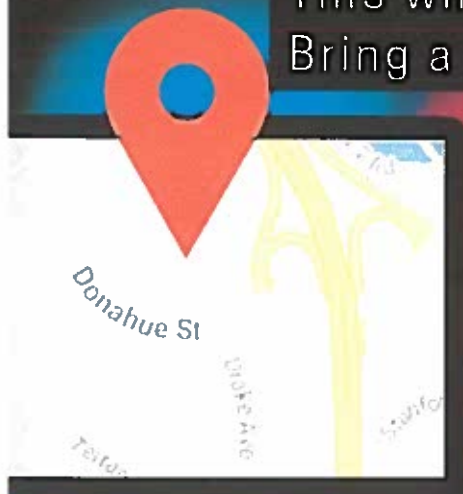
LIGHT THE TUNNEL
