- In Language Arts, we continued learning about bats and the kids wrote and drew pictures about bat facts and added to our Writer's Corner wall. We also decorated bat door hangers for Halloween. We learned the new word "green" this week. So far, we have learned see, like, green, red, a, I, one and two. Make sure to practice these words at home each night. We continued eating the alphabet with blueberry jam (thanks Anna!), and homemade tortillas made in class!
  - In Math, we read the book Stellaluna and made Stellaluna shape recognition books. The kids rocked it again on Dreambox this week! We also counted with bears and recorded the number of bears each student was able to grab in a handful.
