Board Policy 4112

Health Examinations: Tuberculin

1. No person shall be employed by Willow Creek Academy unless they have submitted proof of an examination within the last sixty (60) days that they are free of active tuberculosis by a physician licensed under Chapter 5 of Division 2 of the Business and Professions Code.
2. This examination shall consist of an X-ray of the lungs or an approved intradermal tuberculin test, which, if positive, shall be followed by an X-ray of the lungs.
3. All employees shall be required to undergo this examination at least once every four (4) years
4. After such examination each employee shall file a certificate with Willow Creek Academy from the examining physician showing the employee was examined and found free from active tuberculosis.
5. In the event it becomes necessary for the employee to have an X-ray examination as a follow-up to a skin test, Willow Creek Academy will make arrangements with the designated physician for the examination and bear the expense. If the employee chooses to have his or her own physician for this purpose, Willow Creek Academy will pay toward the cost of the examination an amount equal to the rate charged by the designated physician.
6. This policy shall also include student teachers serving under the supervision of a designated master teacher and all substitute employees.
